

# 24th Annual Arnold Markle Symposium

## *Police Involved Shooting Incidents: Legal Process, Investigation and Forensic Evidence.*

*October 2nd and 3rd, 2015 at the University of New Haven's Bucknall Theater in Dodds Hall*

The 24th Annual Arnold Markle Symposium will be held in Bucknall Theater in Dodds Hall at the University of New Haven on October 2, 3, 2015. The program will run from 8:30 am – 4:00 pm each day and the annual opening ceremony will be Friday October 2nd. This year's speakers will include notable national speakers, who have researched and published on the topic, legal and law enforcement experts in police involved shootings. Dr. Michael Baden, New York State Medical Examiner (Ret.) will address the medical examiner's perspective. Chief Melvin Tucker addresses shootings from the police chief's perspective. Dr. Cyril Wecht discusses pathology and causes of death. Dr. Henry C. Lee, founder of the Institute, will address shooting reconstruction and shooting scenes. Robert P. McCulloch is the Prosecuting Attorney for St. Louis County, Missouri, nationally recognized for the investigation in Ferguson, Missouri. Mr. McCulloch will bring the perspective of the prosecuting attorney in police shooting incidents.

**Tuition remains the same, and affordable for all, according to the vision of Arnold Markle, former State's Attorney and professor. The cost for the two days is \$150.00 per person, and for agencies that register five attendees, the fifth person attends at no cost.
